

Evidence of Identity Requirements

Evidence of identity (EOI) documents must be made up of three matching original EOI documents. The three evidence of identity documents can be made up of either:

- one category A and two category B or
- two category A and one category B

Queensland Accreditation / Authorisation: driver/rider trainer; pilot/escort vehicle driver; dangerous goods driver; tow truck driver/assistant; traffic controller; passenger transport driver (bus, taxi, limousine).	
DHA – ImmiCard; Temporary or Resident Visa; Document for travel to Australia. Note: Electronic Travel Authority (ETS) is not accepted	
Queensland Card 18+ (laminated)	Issued after 01/01/92

CATEGORY B DOCUMENTS – must be Australian issued documents

Australian Defence Force photo identity card (excluding civilians)	Current
Australian Firearm Licence	
Australian Security Guard/Crowd Controller Licence (with photo)	
Education institution student identity document (must include photo and/or signature)	
Financial Institution debit/credit card (must include signature and embossed/printed name)	
Medicare Card; Department of Human Services BasicsCard	
Interstate government-issued or government-approved photo identity card	

SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS

Secondary School Students

The identity of the student may be verified by producing at least one Category A document

and a written statement, on school letter head and signed by a school official. The statement must include the student's full name, date of birth and confirm that the student currently attends the institution.

Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders

The identity of the person may be verified by producing at least one Category A or Category B document and written statements from two authorised referees.

Temporary overseas workers

The identity of the person may be verified by producing:

- a current passport, and
- a current work visa

and one of the following:

- overseas drivers' licence
- overseas financial institution card
- overseas birth certificate
